E-LEARNING POLICY

Aim:

To develop positive attitudes towards computers and related information and communications technologies (ICT) within the total school community and to make our school community members 'computer confident.'

GUIDELINES:

1. There will be at least four computers/lpads and appropriate software available in each Grade Prep-6 classroom.
2. Students in the classroom will have access to the computer for activities to develop skills across the AusVELS Domains.
3. Students will be taught correct computer operation skills, including keyboarding and computer care procedures in class by the ICT specialist teacher.
4. The designated E- learning person/ICT technician will be responsible for distribution, maintenance and upgrading of computer software and hardware, within the E learning budget guidelines.
5. All teachers will have access to relevant professional E-learning so as to maximize the use of ICT within the curriculum to facilitate learning.
6. An E-Learning program budget will be prepared and reviewed each year.
7. The school has a 'Code of Conduct' for students accessing the Internet.

EVALUATION:

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's four year review cycle.
